HORSE COUNCIL BC INDUSTRY GUIDE

As you may have heard, the format for the HCBC Horse Industry Guide is changing! In response to membership input and strategic direction decisions, Horse Council BC has recognized that we are primarily a membership service and support business. In 2007, listings in the Horse Council Industry Guide are included as a benefit of Business membership, and all business members will be listed automatically.

The 2007 HCBC Horse Industry Guide will be the information and contact resource our members value so highly, and will be a "phone book" for the Horse Industry and all its related services here in BC. Imagine a horse industry specific white pages phone book, sent to all 21,000 Horse Council of BC members just like your phone books are sent to you now, and you imagine the 2007 Guide.

The 2007 Guide will be published on line, in a PDF format to allow easy printing, or be available by request in a print format from the HCBC office. Online listings will include an embedded link directly to the member's website, or email address (or both if you have both). The cost for a Business membership for 2007 is \$65, and for our Business members who wish to have services listed in multiple areas of the Guide, the cost will be \$25 plus taxes for each additional listing. For our Business members with multiple outlets around the province, and HCBC business affinity partners we are looking for sponsors for the Guide, and will be happy to discuss how HCBC can work with your business to promote to our members.

The 2007 guide is really about promoting members to members, and providing the Horse Industry in BC with reliable, reputable information in a not for profit Guide. This goal supports our member service philosophy and we hope you will all join us in supporting Horse Council, and our 2007 Guide.

The Coaches list and Officials list will be included in the **HCBC Industry Guide** as they have always been and in the same format as in past years. Pacific and Prairie Horse Journals will be printing their own separate Guide and are asking for paid advertising. These are two **separate** and **distinct** Industry Guides. In the **HCBC** Industry Guide, there is another option for Coaches who wish to have more advertising than their one line listing. Coaches can also become business members of HCBC (in addition to their personal membership) and that membership offers an additional free ad space of approximately 1/8 of a page in the **HCBC** Industry Guide. The content of this extra ad would be of the coach's choice. The only advertising accepted in the **HCBC** Industry Guide will be from **HCBC** Business members, providing a better service and promotion for them. The entire directory will be available in print format as well as on our website

for viewing or .pdf download. The links to coach's websites and emails would be live links for easy access. This **HCBC Industry Guide** would also be updated on a quarterly basis. As always, the Officials and Coaches are listed on the HCBC website under their respective sections and will continue to be there in addition to the free listing in the **HCBC Industry Guide**.
