



ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS:

- Open to all breeds and grade horses.
- Both owners and riders must be either WCRA members or pay a show fee.
- All cheques payable to WCRA KAMLOOPS CHAPTER. **Payment must be postmarked June 1st, 2007 or a \$25.00 late fee *per class* will be added.**
- There will be no entry refunds, but substitutions of horses will be allowed upon presentation of a veterinary certificate, or riders with a doctor's note, as proof of inability to compete and a \$25.00 substitution fee.
- **There will be a \$10.00 office charge for incomplete entry forms.**
- Return cheques shall not be considered timely payments and if not made good until after the entry deadline a penalty of \$25.00 shall apply.
- US payments must be made in Canadian funds with a money order or bank draft.
- Rider substitution will be allowed up to 2 hours before class.
- Post entries accepted until 2 hours before the class starts and will be added to the beginning of Judge's sheets.
- **NO POST ENTRIES IN WORKING COW HORSE CLASSES.**
- An Owner may enter more than one horse and/or a rider may ride more than one horse. A rider may not show more than 3 horses in a class and a horse may be entered only once in a class.
- Owners of registered horse must include a photocopy of the registration papers with payment.

GENERAL RULES:

- All reining classes will be judged according to the NRHA rulebook and WCRA High Point rules. In the case of a conflict, WCRA rules will be used.
- Payments will be made according to the current NRHA rulebook. 40% retainage.
- WCRA Kamloops Chapter show committee will select the patterns to be used. Any pattern changes will be posted at least 1 hour before the class to which it applies.
- Inhumane treatment of horses will be grounds for disqualification.
- Ties will be worked off using the same pattern and order of go as was used during the event, however, there will not be more than one run-off per class. The tied exhibitors have the alternate option of agreeing not to run-off and to be named co-champions but must determine the winner of the awards by a flip of a coin. If they do not agree the exhibitor who does not want to run-off will forfeit first place to the other.
- WCRA Kamloops Chapter reserves the right to cancel, transfer or reschedule the show without notice and/or liability in the event of a cancellation, all entry fees will be refunded.
- Photocopy of horse's registration papers must accompany payment. Horse Council BC and WCRA membership numbers must be supplied.
- In order to be eligible to collect points towards WCRA HIGH POINT year-end awards, riders and owners must be members in good standing of the WCRA prior to competing in the class. Points are tabulated according to the current NRHA Youth Point Scale and are based on horse and rider combination. The same horse/rider combination must compete in a minimum of two WCRA High Point shows in the current year in order to be eligible for a High Point Award. See current WCRA High Point Rule book for complete guidelines and rules.
